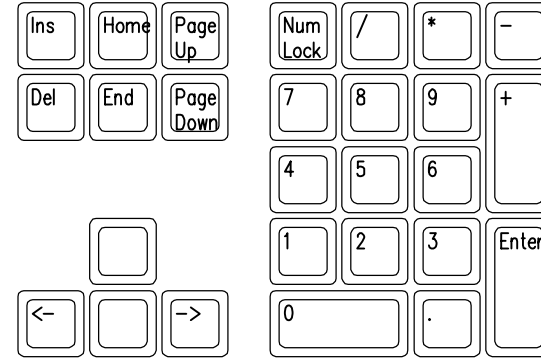
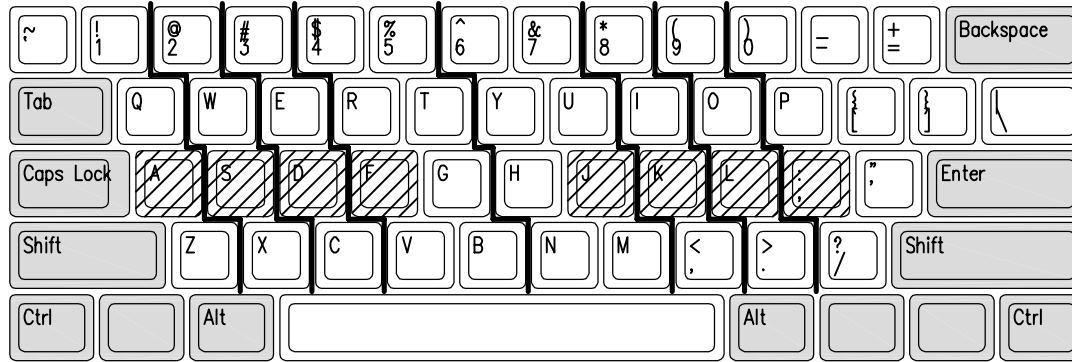
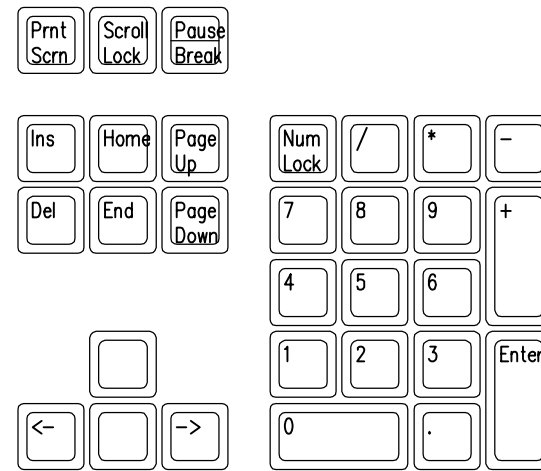
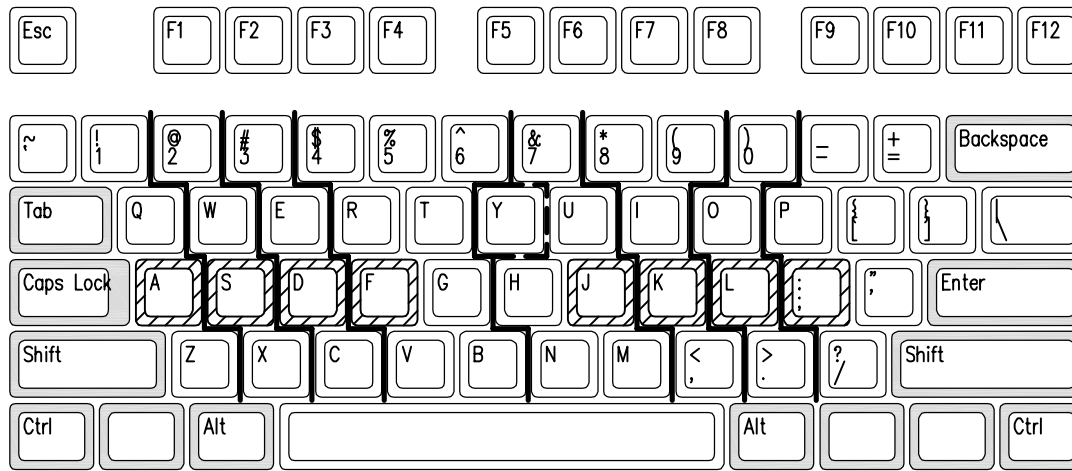


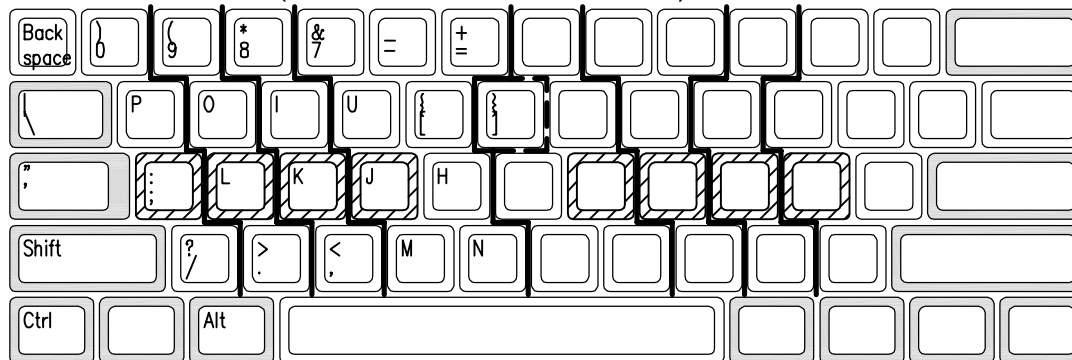
## STANDARD FINGER POSITION

## "ScrollLock" DOWN (MOUSE THUMB BUTTON)



### LEFT-HAND TYPING NOTES:

1. You are expected to reach the "6" and "Y" keys with your left index finger (modified "5", "6", "T", & "Y" are used for symbols).
2. The mouse's thumb button should be assigned to "ScrollLock" (the thumb button is what's being referred to in most cases below).

### POSSIBLE FUTURE MODS:

SWAP ">" & "<" (BUT NOT ">" & "<")

SWAP ")" & "(" (BUT NOT "0" & "9")

figure out a way to do "Back" in file dialogs besides AutoCAD (then make "Fwd" = "Up One Level" & "Back" = "Back")

### SPECIAL KEYS & COMBOS:

ScrollLock = Esc (in AutoCAD or Excel)

= Alt+2 ("Up One Level" in "Save Drawing As"; FYI Alt+1 is "Back")

= Backspace ("Up One Level" in "Save Web Page", "Save As", or "Save a file"; must deselect file name first)

= Alt+NumpadLeft (Alt+Numpad4; "Back" in Internet Explorer)

Shift+CapsLock = "

ScrollLock+RightButton = Enter (Return)

Ctrl+ScrollLock = ScrollLock (the real one - to toggle)
